

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:

- 1) *The petitioner has cause of action against the respondents.*
- 2) *The written comments of the respondent No .1 are vague and they need to be clarified*
- 3) *The written comments of the respondent No .1 are baseless and incorrect.*
- 4) *On the basis of Interview, neither cadet has been drop from merit list, nor shown nor counted separately cadets are selected on overall performance. There is no tradition or law of any cadet college of Pakistan as a separate category for selection.*
- 5) *That Interview marks have not been mentioned in the college prospectus. (copy of prospectus is annexed X)*
- 6) *The written test marks and interview marks of the petitioner and others cadets have been wrongly calculated by the respondents.*

- 7) *All the preliminary objections raised by respondent No.1 in his written comments are baseless and incorrect.*
- 8) *That respondents directed father of petitioner to give financial undertaking but fees of the petitioner has been received on self finance. (copy of undertaking is annexure XI)*
- 9) *The respondent No.1 is legally bound to produce attested photocopies of merit list, final result, list of written marks, list interview marks of total 33 cadets for KP less Malakand Division and approved final list of cadets by GOC. But the respondent No.1 did not produce the same before this Honorable Court.*

ON FACTS:

- 1) *Para No.1 of the comments filed by respondent No.1 is incorrect, hence denied. The Administration of the college exceeds their powers as they allow admissions to the students on the basis of pick & choose policy and did not care of merits, so this directly infringed the vested rights of deserving students.*
- 2) *Para No.2 of the comments filed by respondents is incorrect.*
- 3) *Para No.3 of the comments is incorrect, hence denied, the respondent No.1 has wrongly calculated the written test and interview marks of the petitioner along with three other cadets. The respondent No. 1 produced fake result of the petitioner along with three other cadets in the shape of annexure A. Result shown by the respondent No .1 of the petitioner along with three other students is baseless and malafide, the correct calculation of written test marks and interview marks of the petitioner along with three other cadets namely Uzair Khan , M. Rehan Shahid, Muzamil Zulfiqar are as under.*

- 3) Muzamil Zulfiqar Role No 6000838($(100 \times 11 + 180 \div 320 = 59.68 \%)$)
 4) M. Rehan Shahid Role No($(100 \times 12 + 176 \div 320 = 58.75 \%)$)

From the above correct calculation petitioner gained the second position in the aggregate and the petitioner qualified the admission in open merits. The respondent No. 1 produced fake result in the shape of annexure A and did not produce attested photocopies of merit list, final result, list of written marks, list interview marks of total 33 cadets for KP less Malakand Division and approved final list of cadets by GOC. Which shows the malafide intention of the respondent No. 1.

- 4) Para No.4 of the comments filed by respondents is correct to the extent of submitting an application, rest of para is incorrect, hence denied. Details already given in the para No.3.
- 5) Para No.5 of the comments filed by respondents is incorrect, hence denied, the petitioner has not been considered for admission on open merit as some other cadets, the petitioner was dealt with discriminately and was given admission in self-finance.
- 6) Para No.6 of the comments filed by respondents is incorrect, hence denied. Depriving the petitioner the respondents made discrimination with the petitioner.
- 7) Para No.7 of the comments filed by respondents is incorrect, if correct marks of petitioner be calculated then the petitioner will gain second position in the aggregate and will be qualified the admission in open merits. The respondent No. 1 produced fake result in the shape of annexure A and did not produce the actual and correct record before this Honorable Court.
- 8) Para No.8 of the comments filed by respondents is incorrect. Details already given in the above para.3.

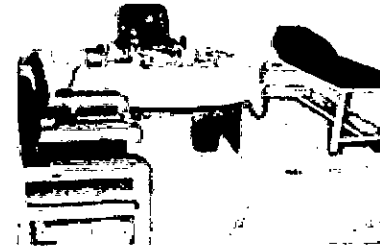


College Hospital

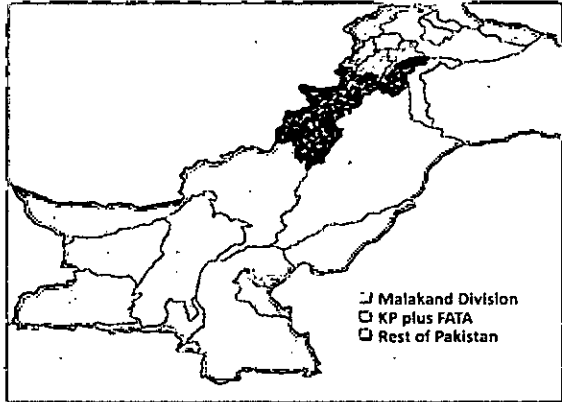

Procedure

- Admissions are announced / advertised in English / Urdu national dailies in the month of September / October for class VIII and in April for class XI.
- Parents are required to process the admission by submitting following forms:-
 - ❖ Admission Form - (Annex-A)
 - ❖ Undertaking - (Annex-B)
 - ❖ Address Slip - (Annex-C)
- Admission details and advertisement can also be seen on the college official website www.cadetcollegeswat.edu.pk.
- Registered candidates will be allotted roll numbers and informed of their place and date of written test.
- Roll number slips will only be sent to eligible candidates.
- Examination centers for the written tests and interviews shall be at **Swat, Rawalpindi / Isiamabad, Peshawar, Lahore, Karachi and Quetta**. Candidates are to indicate their choice of center in the application forms. In case there are less than 50 candidates at a particular centre, the candidates will be called to appear at the nearest centre.

- Additional examination centres can also be made available if strength of that particular place exceeds 50 candidates. The information for the additional centres will be intimated to all concerned.

- Candidates qualifying the written examination shall be intimated through mail about the date/place for interview and medical examination.
- During the medical examination the candidate's height and weight will be checked against the BMI (body mass index - available on the internet). Any one OVERWEIGHT will be rejected. In addition anyone suffering from chronic Epilepsy; Bronchitis; Asthma; TB; Anxiety or taking medicines regularly on long term basis will be declared medically UNFIT. Such candidates need not apply to prevent embarrassment later.
- Final results shall be compiled and successful candidates will be issued joining instructions along with date of reporting at the college in writing. Finally selected candidates must fulfill the requirement as mentioned in the joining instructions prior to reporting.
- Selection will be purely on merit basis.
- Selection procedure will be kept confidential and is not liable to any representation.
- Every candidate is required to remit an examination fee of Rs. 1000/- (non refundable) with the application form.

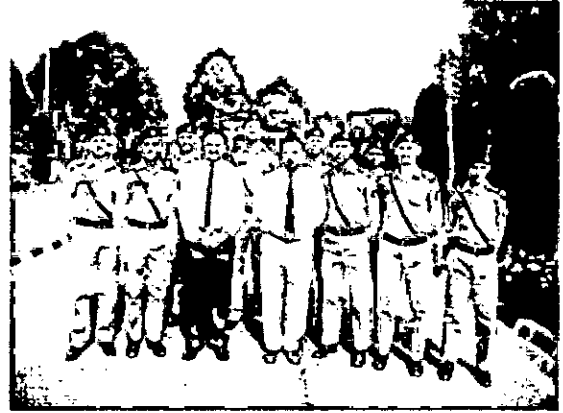

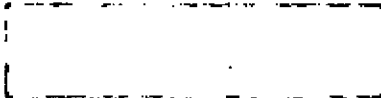


Procedure of Payment

- The fee should be paid through bank drafts / pay orders or in cash. Cheques are not acceptable. Bank drafts / pay orders should be in favour of "Principal, Cadet College Swat". The cadet number, class and name should be mentioned in the covering letter and on the reverse of the bank draft / pay order. Fee in cash will only be deposited with the CFO or the accountant and receipt to this effect be collected.
- If fee is not received within due date, the cadet will be fined @ Rs.50/- per day for the first ten days, Rs. 100/- per day for the next 10 days and Rs. 500/- per day for the next ten days. Thereafter, his name will be struck off the college rolls if dues are not received after 30 days of the due date. Readmission, if approved by the Principal, will be granted on payment of Rs. 10,000/- in addition to the above fine/penalty.
- If fee is not fully cleared, the defaulting cadet's admission form for annual examinations shall not be forwarded to the board. Even if the form has been dispatched, the cadet concerned will not be allowed to appear in the annual examination, unless his account has been completely settled.

Umrah / Hajj Leave

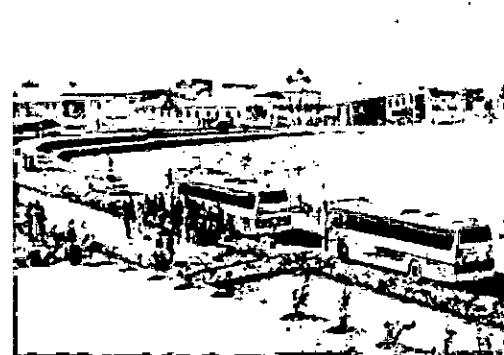

Special Leave

Special leave will only be granted to cadets for attending special ceremonies related to their immediate family members.

Emergency Leave

Emergency leave may be granted for the death of an immediate family member; requests for emergency leave must be initiated by a parent / guardian of the cadet or duly authorised representative, followed by a written request.

Withdrawal of a Cadet

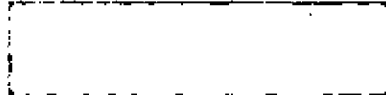

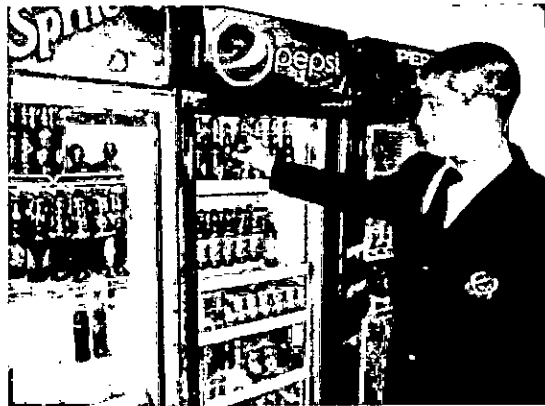

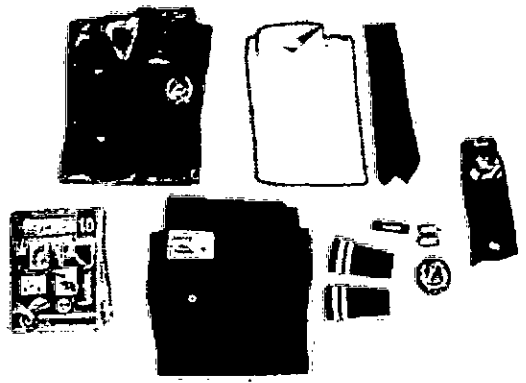
Pocket Money

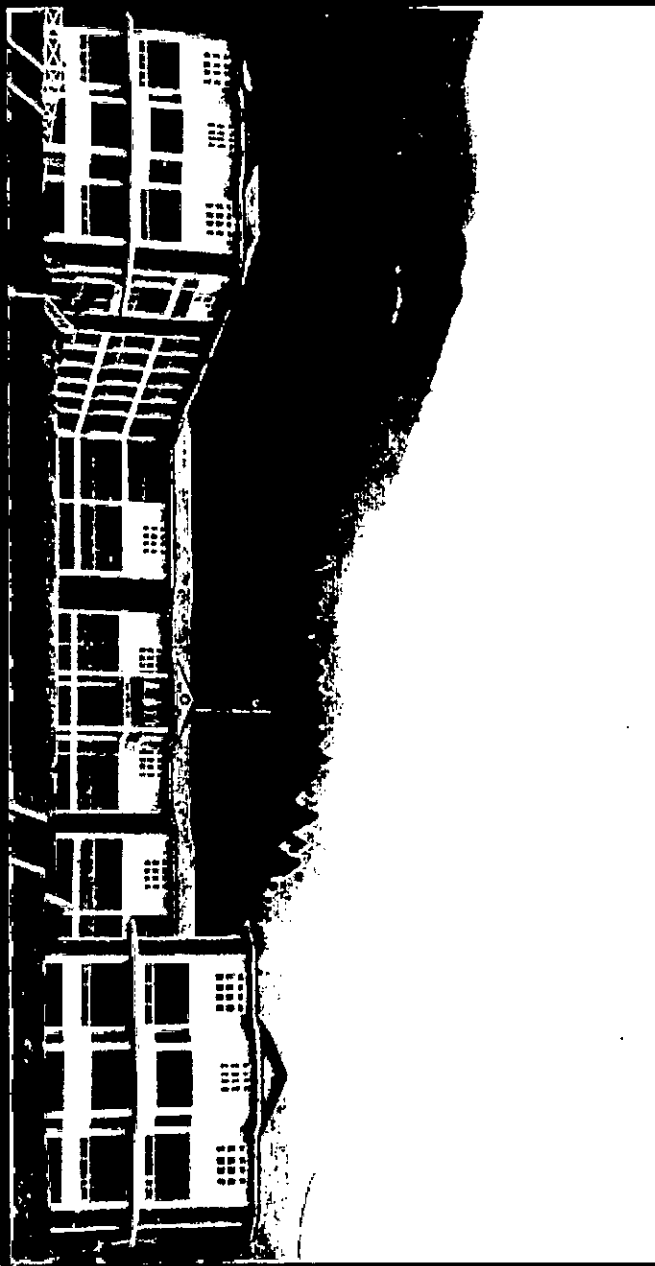
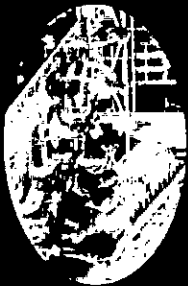

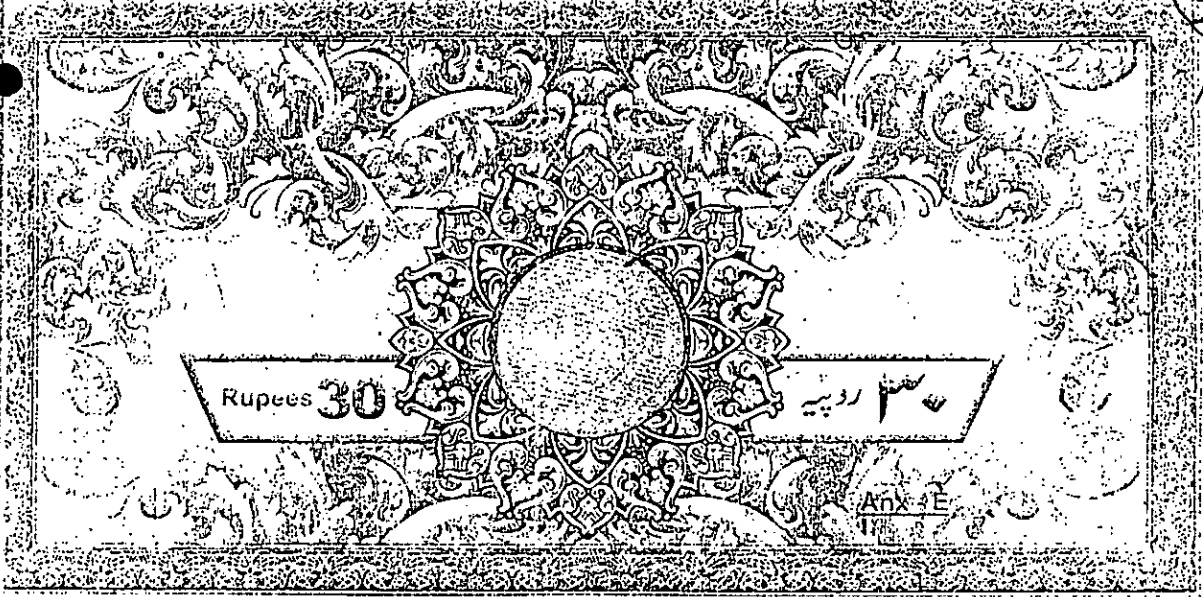
