





### **Month Wise Pendency Trend excluding NMDs**









 Organized Trainings with District Judiciary on Child Protection Laws, Court Staff Recruitment Rules, Gender Based Violence Laws.




 To clear the backlog of Cases, affected during Covid-19 Public Holidays, Summer Vacation were reduced.

- Established Branch Registry for the PHC and Benches for remotely Institution and Copying Branch.






